Five Flaws in the False Doctrine of “Original Sin”

1. The first flaw in the damnable doctrine of “Original Sin” is that it blasphemes the Creator!

Psalm 139:13 (ESV) For you formed my inward parts; you knitted me together in my mother’s womb.

If babies are born with a “sin nature,” then God made them that way because He knit them together in the womb!

2. The second flaw in the damnable doctrine of “Original Sin” is that it blasphemes the image of God!

Genesis 9:6 (ESV) “Whoever sheds the blood of man, by man shall his blood be shed, for God made man in his own image.

1 Corinthians 11:7 (ESV) ...a man ought not to cover his head, since he is the image and glory of God...

If babies are born with a “sin nature,” then the image of God must be tainted by a “sin nature.”

3. The third flaw in the damnable doctrine of “Original Sin” is that it blasphemes the Lord’s salvation!

Romans 5:18 (ESV) Therefore, as one trespass led to condemnation for all men, so one act of righteousness leads to justification and life for all men.

If babies are born with a “sin nature,” then the Lord’s righteous nature must also be forced upon them. If Adam condemned us all, then Jesus made us all righteous. What is true of the first part of the verse has to be true in the second part. This verse is clearly referring to the outcome of our choices, not what is forced upon us through inheritance.

4. The fourth flaw in the damnable doctrine of “Original Sin” is that it blasphemes the high priesthood of Christ!

Hebrews 4:15 (ESV) For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin.

If babies are born with a “sin nature,” then Jesus would have needed to experience that level of temptation in order to be our perfect high priest.

5. The fifth flaw in the damnable doctrine of “Original Sin” is that it blasphemes the kingdom of God!

Deuteronomy 1:39 (ESV) And as for your little ones, who you said would become a prey, and your children, who today have no knowledge of good or evil...

Mark 10:14 (ESV) “Let the children come to me; do not hinder them, for to such belongs the kingdom of God.”

If babies are born with a “sin nature,” then the kingdom of God has a “sin nature.”

The doctrine of "Original Sin," which claims we inherit a "sin nature" from Adam, is a damnable doctrine because it blasphemes the Creator, His image, the Lord's salvation, His high priesthood, and the very kingdom of God.
